RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER FOR THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.2 (the "Statute"), each public agency shall designate an individual to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer ("PACO"); and

WHEREAS, the PACO is the liaison between the New Jersey Division of Purchase and Property and the Public Agency and is the Public Agency point of contact for all matters concerning implementation and administration of the Statute; and

WHEREAS, the PACO is also responsible for administering contracting procedures pertaining to Equal Employment Opportunity regarding both the Public Agency and the service providers; and

WHEREAS, each year, all Public Agencies are required to submit the name, title, address, telephone, number, fax, and email address of the PACO designated by the Public Agency; and

WHEREAS, Michael A. Aimino, Esquire, Conflict Solicitor to the Salem County Improvement Authority (the "SCIA") is qualified to handle the duties and obligations of the PACO and he shall assume these duties and responsibilities upon the resignation of the current PACO, Mark Shoemaker, Esquire;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Michael A. Aimino, Esquire, Conflict Solicitor, shall serve as PACO for the SCIA upon the resignation of the current PACO, Mark Shoemaker, Esquire.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mr. Aimino's name, title, address, telephone, number, fax, and email address shall be immediately submitted to the Division of Purchase and Property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary will certify a copy of this Resolution and file it on the public record.
