**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY**  
**TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR COLLECTION, RECYCLING AND/OR**  
**DISPOSAL FOR THE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COUNTYWIDE**  
**COLLECTION PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Salem County Improvement Authority (“SCIA”) is in need of services in connection with the operation of its Household Hazardous Waste Countywide Collection Program (“HHW Collection”); and


**WHEREAS**, the SCIA has determined that the cost of the 2021 HHW Collection contract may exceed \$44,000, which is in excess of SCIA’s bid threshold amount; and


**WHEREAS**, obtaining such goods and services of qualified companies must follow New Jersey Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the SCIA has determined that soliciting publicly advertised bids is required pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4 under the circumstances presented, is to the advantage of the SCIA and makes the process more open and competitive;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the SCIA as follows:


1. The Salem County Purchasing Agent has prepared bid specifications for the HHW Collection.
2. The SCIA Executive Director shall publish a public notice of solicitation for public bids for such goods and services in accordance with the requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 *et seq.*
3. The SCIA Executive Director shall make the necessary arrangements to publicly open and announce all bids received. The SCIA Executive Director shall immediately review all bids received and transmit them to the SCIA members with a report and recommendations.
4. Award of any contracts based on the submissions received shall be made by Resolution of the SCIA Board at an open public meeting.
