**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2021-04 AUTHORIZING  
APPLICATION FOR 2020 RECYCLING ENHANCEMENT ACT TAX GRANT**


WHEREAS, the Salem County Improvement Authority (“SCIA”) has the full and complete authority to received and expend funds related to grant programs, including the Recycling Enhancement Act Tax Grant, as per Resolution #2009-153 that was adopted by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of Salem County; and


WHEREAS, as a result, the SCIA is eligible for the 2020 Recycling Enhancement Act – Direct Recycling Grants to Counties Grant Funding (the “Grant”); and

WHEREAS, SCIA passed Resolution 2020-04 in anticipation of the Grant amount being \$143,320 or more; however, it has now been learned that the amount for 2020 is \$162,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Grant is expected to be in the amount of \$162,000.00 for the year 2020;


