#### **MINUTES**

Regular meeting of November 10, 2021 **(M) Bestwick (S) DiMatteo** to approve minutes. Motion carried by voice vote of 5-0.

#### CORRESPONDENCE

Executive Director Acton noted correspondence consisted of a letter from Statewide Insurance approving the safety grant application which is being used to repair the gate.

#### EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Copies of this report were distributed to all members prior to the meeting. Executive Director Acton advised that the flare control panel is ready for installation and same will take about a month. Board Member Barry Davis asked if there would be an operation manual and Landfill Manager Parker Smith advised that there will be a manual and training will be provided. The tool truck has been ordered and delivery is expected during the last quarter of 2022. There is a resolution on the agenda authorizing the advertising and purchase of a new landfill compactor. There is a resolution on the agenda to sell the 2009 compactor to a private company since there were no responses when it was advertised on GovDeals.com. The Landfill Manager's pickup truck has been repaired and there is a resolution on the agenda regarding approved use of the pickup truck. The bird permit resolution is on the agenda and Executive Director Acton thanked the Solicitor for his work on the resolution and the attachments. The wage increase resolution is on the agenda, as well as a resolution authorizing advertising for the Request for Professionals and approval of the holiday schedule.

Board member Lew Schneider requested to know the procedure when the office is closed, and the landfill is open and Executive Director Acton advised that the landfill staff is able to take a different day off during the following week. This is known as a floating holiday.

#### SOLID WASTE REPORTS

Landfill Statistical Report, Engineer's Report and Landfill Manager's Report. Copies of these reports were distributed to all members prior to the meeting and Executive Director Acton advised that landfill tonnage revenue is up, the price per ton is down slightly, cover expense was zero, and leachate costs are down. It was noted that there was a groundwater inspection by the NJDEP and an NOV was issued regarding the 2nd and 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter reports and sampling, and the fecal coliform problem, and same was discussed briefly.
