MINUTES

Regular meeting of December 9, 2021 **(M) Bestwick (S) Schneider** to approve minutes. Motion carried by voice vote of 5-0.

CORRESPONDENCE

Executive Director Acton noted correspondence consisted of a letter from the NJDEP approving the name change from South Jersey Agricultural Products to OldCastle Lawns and Landscapes.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Copies of this report were distributed to all members prior to the meeting. Executive Director Acton advised that with regard to the customer again report, Dephi Engineering continues to make payments and she is pleased with the progress they are making. There is a resolution on the agenda for change order #1 for the Flare Control Panel Upgrade. There is a need to install two motors that were previously purchase and to wire the transformer due to missing pages in the bid specifications. The water truck bid opening took place on January 5 and there is a resolution on the agenda to award this bid. The landfill compactor is getting the required upgrades and its expected delivery date is January 19. TANA is preparing a press release and there will be a small opening on January 24, 2022, at 3:30PM. The boiler in the warehouse was replaced as it stopped working, the facia and gutters on the building have been replaced and repaired, and a contractor has been selected to build the Landfill Manager's office. SCIA is currently looking to replace the backhoe and a landfill truck and the new insurance proposal has been received. There was an increase in the premium due to cyber crime coverage. The networking event regarding the Bag Ban Law has been moved to April 7 from January 20 due to covid. There is a resolution on the agenda to approve the expense to print and mail the countywide recycling and litter abatement and a sample flyer was reviewed. The State of the County event is being held at Creekside Inn in Woodstown.

SOLID WASTE REPORTS

Landfill Statistical Report, Engineer's Report and Landfill Manager's Report. Copies of these reports were distributed to all members prior to the meeting and Executive Director Acton advised that landfill tonnage revenue was down for the month of December, but the yearend revenue ended up vs. the year before. Leachate cost was down \$300,000 compared to 2020. Cover expense was zero. Beneficial soil revenue definitely pays for the additional help needed in the scale house. There was a DEP inspection and it was very good with the exception of a small amount of trash on Cell 4, which was corrected.

STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS

Executive Committee (Susan Bestwick) – Committee Chairman Bestwick advised that their discussion centered mostly around the potential for creation of the new Economic Development office for the County.

Ad Hoc Committee (Steven DiMatteo) – Committee Chairman DiMatteo advised that he has no updates at this time.

Personnel Committee (Lewis Schneider) – Committee Chairman Schneider asked a couple of questions regarding the hiring of the seasonal laborers and advised he had nothing else to discuss at this time.

Solid Waste Committee (Barry Davis) – Committee Chairman Davis advised that the EGC repair had commenced and he requested the Landfill Engineer be present when the cutting of the liner takes place. The training on the flare control panel has not happened yet due to some "bugs' with the flare, but the Landfill Manager advised that the flare should be restarted on Friday, January 14. The Landfill Engineer did not find any additional sources of the fecal contamination and "the ball is in the State's court" now. Committee Chairman Davis advised that there would be a visit to Cape May County to view their EGC in February unless there is snow.

Chairman Taylor, without objection, ordered the Executive Director's report, landfill statistical report, Engineer's report and the committee reports be received and filed.
