Cordy Taylor called the meeting to order at 4:30 pm and read the Open Public Meetings Act statement. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present.

Julie Acton, Executive Director, Parker Smith, Landfill Manager, Florence Beckett, Recording Secretary, Edward Ramsay, County Commissioner, and Michael Aimino, Esquire, were present. Salem City Mayor Jody Veler, Salem City Council President Earl Gage and Salem City CFO Kenya Nunez were also present.

CITY OF SALEM BONDING REQUEST PRESENTATION

Salem City Council President Earl Gage gave a presentation regarding the request by the City of Salem for bonding regarding the purchase of a new fire truck, recycling collection truck and street sweeper. Council President Gage advised that the City would pay all fees associated with the bonding process. They will be producing a resolution memorializing the City's intentions soon.

MINUTES

Regular meeting of February 10, 2022 **(M) Bestwick (S) Davis** to approve minutes. Motion carried by voice vote of 3-0.

CORRESPONDENCE

No correspondence was received.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Copies of this report were distributed to all members prior to the meeting. Executive Director Acton advised that there is a resolution on the agenda to hire the new fee accountant and the previous fee accountant has an appointment set up to transition files and information. The new landfill manager's office is moving along quickly and RM Sickler is doing a very good job. The piping has been removed from the warehouse and the flare panel installation project is complete. Compaction on the landfill is up 10% due to the efficiency of the new compactor and the Bomag has been fixed. Atlantic City Electric replaced three transformers at no cost to SCIA. There was a Salem County Health Department inspection in cooperation with the NJDEP and both agencies were pleased with the appearance of the landfill. They advised that there must be an annual leachate pipe cleanout and that will be accomplished. Executive Director Acton advised that there is a need for seasonal laborers.

SOLID WASTE REPORTS

Landfill Statistical Report, Engineer's Report and Landfill Manager's Report. Copies of these reports were distributed to all members prior to the meeting and Executive Director Acton advised that landfill tonnage revenue is up, the average price per ton is up, Convenience Center revenue is up, leachate expense is down and beneficial soil income is up. The engineer will be starting the topographical survey and the report is due at the beginning of May 1. To update the fecal coliform matter, the engineer sent correspondence to the NJDEP on January 7 and to date there has been no response.

STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS

Executive Committee (Susan Bestwick) – Committee Chairman Bestwick advised that she had nothing to add to the discussion except that the trip to the Cape May landfill was interesting.

Ad Hoc Committee (Steven DiMatteo) – Committee Chairman DiMatteo was not present.

Personnel Committee (Lewis Schneider) – Committee Chairman Schneider was not present; however, Executive Director Acton advised that Board member Schneider was on board with the revisions to the uniform policy and to the job descriptions for the Scalemaster and the Assistant Clean Communities Coordinator. These items are on the agenda for action by the Board.

Solid Waste Committee (Barry Davis) – Committee Chairman Davis advised that the next two projects will be to replace the outbound scale, which will take approximately a year to receive, and redundancy equipment on the flare. The Executive Director advised that the engineer will begin work on the bid specifications for the project on the outbound scale. Board Chairman asked if the scale can be painted to deter rust and the Executive Director will look into this. To try to extend the life of the outbound scale, plates were installed and two load cells were replaced.

Chairman Taylor, without objection, ordered the Executive Director's report, landfill statistical report, Engineer's report and the committee reports be received and filed.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Finlaw Building was discussed, and it was noted that Senator Sweeney's office has vacated the building. It was confirmed that the Executive Director will continue to pursue someone to sublease SCIA's basement office space.
