RESOLUTION OF THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT ("SCIA") AUTHORITY RECOGNIZING JUNETEENTH AS AN OFFICIAL HOLIDAY FOR SCIA

WHEREAS, Juneteenth commemorates June 19, 1865, the day General Gordon Granger rode into Galveston, Texas, with the news that the Civil War had ended and the enslave were free; and

WHEREAS, celebration of Juneteenth symbolizes freedom, celebrates the abolition of slavery and reminds all American of the significant contributions Black Americans have made to our society; and

WHEREAS, recognizing that the observance of the end of slavery is part of the history and heritage of the United States; and

WHEREAS, it is proper and fitting for SCIA to designate the June 19 as an official holiday to celebrate the emancipation of Black Americans;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by SCIA that Juneteenth is an official holiday and will be celebrated on June 19.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Juneteenth is designated as a "floating" holiday whereby the administrative offices are closed, but landfill is open. Landfill employees will receive a day off within the week of the holiday to ensure that there is always sufficient coverage on the landfill.
