**RESOLUTION OF THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY
AUTHORIZING AWARD OF BID FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE
OUTBOUND SCALE TO ADVANCE SCALE**

WHEREAS, The Salem County Improvement Authority ("SCIA") has a need for construction of the outbound scale; and

WHEREAS, SCIA publicly advertised for the acceptance of open public bids and provided specifications for the scope of the work and the requirements of the bid proposals, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened publicly on September 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the bidder submitting the lowest responsible bid was Advance Scale, of Woodbury, New Jersey in the amount of \$169,426.67; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Advance Scale was within an acceptable financial range of expense anticipated by SCIA and is within the SCIA's budgeted appropriation for this project; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the Outbound Scale Replacement accounting line item in the full amount of the cost of the replacement and same have been certified by the Certifying Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Salem County Improvement Authority Board as follows:


1. Advance Scale of Woodbury, New Jersey, is hereby awarded a contract to construction the outbound scale, in the amount of \$169,426.67.

These services shall be performed in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the bid specifications for the project and the attached contract and supplemental documents which are on file in the Office of the Executive Director, including compensation as provided for in such documents.

3. The Chairperson and Secretary of SCIA are hereby authorized to execute said contract a copy of which is incorporated herein and made a part of this resolution by reference.
4. A copy of this Resolution shall be kept on file with the designated Custodian of Records for SCIA for inspection by the public.
