#### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Copies of this report were distributed to all members prior to the meeting. Executive Director Acton advised that the Audit exit interview went well and Chairman Taylor noted that there were no findings; only a couple of housekeeping items and they are on the agenda under resolutions #74 and #75. Executive Director Acton advised that the budget will be discussed toward the end of the meeting. She noted that there is a resolution on the agenda regarding the brush chipping, upgrade to the bulldozer fire suppression system, and there is also a resolution regarding a risk assessment to be done by SCS. She noted that there was an inspection by the NJDEP and there were no comments.

#### SOLID WASTE REPORTS

Landfill Statistical Report, Engineer's Report and Landfill Manager's Report. Copies of these reports were distributed to all members prior to the meeting and Executive Director Acton advised that the outbound scale resolution award is on the agenda and the bids that were received were discussed. The Executive Director advised that she spoke to adjoining landowners regarding landfill expansion and Alaimo will be preparing an initial landfill footprint including floodplain, wetlands and land maps. With regard to the statistical report, landfill revenue is up and year to date and monthly is up, and the price per ton is down. Leachate hauling is down and there has been no cover purchased for eight months. Beneficial soil is down and density has increased.

#### STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS

Executive Committee (Susan Bestwick) – Committee Chair Bestwick advised that the budget would be discussed at the end of the meeting.

Solid Waste Committee (Barry Davis) — Committee Chairman Davis advised that the leachate line cleaning had to be halted due to equipment problems by the contractor. The cleaning will be rescheduled when the problems are a fixed. The trees will be removed in mid-October. The leachate evaporator will be discussed with DCO. The gas well system is an active project for the new cells and same is ongoing. With regard to the fecal coliform matter, a meeting needs to be scheduled with the Bureau Chief and the next steps were discussed. With regard to the agricultural mulch, the NJDEP will not abate the REA tax that will have to be paid when the mulch is landfilled. A plan going forward was briefly discussed.

**Personnel Committee (Lewis Schneider)** – Committee Chairman Schneider advised that there was an incident with an employee who subsequently resigned. He is not being replaced at this time.

Ad hoc Committee (Steven DiMatteo) - Committee Chairman DiMatteo advised that he had nothing to add.

Vice Chair Bestwick, without objection, ordered the Executive Director's report, landfill statistical report, Engineer's report and the committee reports be received and filed.
