# RESOLUTION OF THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT ("SCIA") AUTHORITY AMENDING RESOLUTION 2022-59 REGARDING THE SCHEDULING OF JUNETEENTH

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2022, SCIA approved Resolution 2022-59 designating June 19 as an official holiday to be celebrated on June 19 of each year; and

WHEREAS, it has come to light that the State of New Jersey has designated the third Friday in June as the official Juneteenth holiday; regardless of what day of the week June 19 falls; and

WHEREAS, SCIA desires to follow the State of New Jersey regarding this holiday;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by SCIA that Juneteenth is an official holiday and will be celebrated on the third Friday of June each year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Juneteenth is designated as a "floating" holiday whereby the administrative offices are closed, but landfill is open. Landfill employees will receive a day off within the week of the holiday to ensure that there is always sufficient coverage on the landfill.
