**RESOLUTION OF THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT (“SCIA”) AUTHORITY
AMENDING RESOLUTION 2022-59 REGARDING
THE SCHEDULING OF JUNETEENTH**

WHEREAS, on June 9, 2022, SCIA approved Resolution 2022-59 designating June 19 as an official holiday to be celebrated on June 19 of each year; and


WHEREAS, it has come to light that the State of New Jersey has designated the third Friday in June as the official Juneteenth holiday; regardless of what day of the week June 19 falls; and

WHEREAS, SCIA desires to follow the State of New Jersey regarding this holiday;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by SCIA that Juneteenth is an official holiday and will be celebrated on the third Friday of June each year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Juneteenth is designated as a “floating” holiday whereby the administrative offices are closed, but landfill is open. Landfill employees will receive a day off within the week of the holiday to ensure that there is always sufficient coverage on the landfill.
