WHEREAS, due to the implementation of Flow Control in Salem County, the need exists for the Salem County Improvement Authority ("SCIA") to confirm compliance by haulers; and

WHEREAS, in addition to monitoring to ensure that the requirements of Flow Control are being adhered to, SCIA must also monitor for illegal dumping and make sure recycling guidelines are being followed; and

WHEREAS, the Salem County Department of Health and Human Services ("DOHH") performs routine inspections of containers, haulers and waste at the landfill and off-site; and

WHEREAS, DOHH responds to potential violations; and

WHEREAS, SCIA anticipates that with the implementation of Flow Control, there will be an increased demand on the DOHH staff time that can be off-set through efficiencies;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of both SCIA and DOHH that SCIA provided an on-going annual maintenance fee to DOHH in accordance with the attached Memorandum of Understanding;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the SCIA Board that Julie Acton, Executive Director, is hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding Between the Salem County Improvement Authority and the Salem County Department of Health and Human Services which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.
