RESOLUTION OF THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY
APPROVING AN ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION TO THE
SALEM COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Salem County Improvement Authority (“SCIA”) is responsible for maintaining the Salem County Solid Waste Management Plan (“SCSWMP”); and

WHEREAS, Oldcastle Lawn & Garden, Inc. (“Oldcastle”) currently holds a Class B license, pursuant to New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (“NJDEP”) Permit #CBG240002, which allows it to receive Class B recyclable material, including waste wood from any location, as well as leaves and yard trimmings/brush from Upper Pittsgrove Township, for the production of mulch and soil products; and

WHEREAS, the Oldcastle Class B Recycling Center is currently part of the SCSWMP and is located on Block 60, Lot 11 and Block 57, Lot 1 in Upper Pittsgrove Township; and

WHEREAS, the Oldcastle is requesting that SCIA amend the SCSWMP to include the facility’s Class B Daily Tonnage of 1,000 tons (960 wood / 40 leaves). Also amend to include the following additional materials: Brush, root matt, pallets, pallet gridings, tree chips, wood (non-chemically treated and unpainted), whole trees and stump grinding for the facility Block 60, Lot 11 and Block 57, Lot 1 in Upper Pittsgrove Township; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection is request to have the daily tonnage included to the County’s solid waste management plan for such facilities; and

WHEREAS, Oldcastle will seek approval of this modification from the NJDEP after receipt of SCIA’s issuance of the requested Administrative Action;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the SCIA that the following SWSWMP Amendment shall be made and the SCSWMP shall be modified as follows:

1. Oldcastle’s request to amend its Class B Recycling Center General Approval to have the daily tonnage included to the County’s solid waste management plan, is approved by this Administrative Action.
2. Oldcastle’s Class B Recycling Center Daily Tonnage of 1,000 Tons (960 wood /40 leaves). Also amend to include the following additional materials: Brush, root matt, pallets, pallet grinding, tree chips, wood (non-chemically treated and unpainted), whole trees and stump grinding.
3. All operations of Oldcastle shall be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of the NJDEP and SCIA, as applicable.
