RESOLUTION OF THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY
AUTHORIZING AWARD OF THE BID FOR COLLECTION,
RECYCLING AND DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

WHEREAS, The Salem County Improvement Authority ("SCIA") has a need for the collection, recycling and disposal of household hazardous waste ("HHW"); and

WHEREAS, SCIA publicly advertised for the acceptance of open public bids and provided specifications for the scope of the work and the requirements of the bid proposals, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened publicly on February 4, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the bidder submitting the lowest responsible bid was ACV Environmental Services, Inc. ("ACV") of 928 E. Hazelwood Ave., Rahway NJ 07065, in the amount of \$2.50 per pound as set forth in the bid, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part of this Resolution as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, SCIA has determined the bid from ACV to be the lowest responsible bid, responsive to the request and in the best interest of SCIA and desires to award the bid and to enter into an agreement for the services as described in the bid documents; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by ACV was within an acceptable financial range of expense anticipated by SCIA and is within the SCIA's budgeted appropriation for this project; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the Recycling accounting line item in the full amount of the cost of the two scheduled HHW collection events and have been certified by the Certifying Officer;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by SCIA as follows:

1. The contract for collection, recycling and disposal of HHW is awarded to ACV Environmental Services, Inc. ("ACV") of 928 E. Hazelwood Ave., Rahway NJ 07065.
2. These services shall be performed in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in the bid specifications for the project and the attached contract and supplemental documents which are on file in the Office of the Executive Director, including compensation as provided for in such documents.
3. The Chairman and Secretary are authorized, on behalf of SCIA, to execute a contract that complies with the terms and requirements of the bid and is subject to the preparation, review and/or approval of the SCIA Solicitor.
