RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACT FOR SUPPLYING OF DAILY AND INTERMEDIATE COVER MATERIAL TO THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY SOLID WASTE DIVISION

WHEREAS, the Salem County Improvement Authority solicited, received and opened sealed bids on April 8, 2025, at 1pm prevailing time for Supplying of Daily and Intermediate Cover Material to the SCIA Solid Waste Division Landfill; and

WHEREAS, said bids were duly advertised in accordance with Local Public Contracts Law N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, all bid results and recommendations are on file in the Office of the Executive Director for SCIA as required by Law; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director and Accounts Payable Clerk have reviewed all bid submissions; and

WHEREAS, the bids were as follows:

BIDDER'S NAME	BID
South State Materials, LLC	\$12.49 per ton
DunRite Sand & Gravel Company	\$14.00 per ton

WHEREAS, South State Materials, LLC was the lowest bidder for the Bid; and


WHEREAS South State Materials, LLC did substantially comply with the bid specification in all material respects and therefore is the lowest responsible bidder; and


WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4, the SCIA Treasurer/Finance Officer has provided a certificate of availability of funds that appropriates funds for this contract to the following line item of the **budget account line item #01-05-120-506 Cover Material**;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Members of the Salem County Improvement Authority as follows:

1. The SCIA awards a contract that shall comply with the bid specifications for \$12.49 per ton, subject to the review and approval of the SCIA Solicitor and the SCIA Landfill Manager, South State Materials, LLC to Supply Daily and Intermediate Cover for the SCIA Solid Waste Division.
2. The Chairperson and Executive Director shall be authorized to execute said contract upon compliance by the bidder with the bond and insurance requirements of the specifications.
