RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SALEM AND THE SALEM COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES RELATED TO A PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE VEHICLE EVIDENCE FACILITY.

WHEREAS, County has a need for a secure, large-span structure for the Prosecutor's Office to store seized vehicles and evidence; and

WHEREAS, Salem County Improvement Authority (SCIA) has the knowledge to act as Project Manager; and

WHEREAS, contract is permitted by N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15;

WHEREAS, contract is permitted by N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 that allows these local units to share services; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED the Salem County Improvement Authority approves Scope of Work: Explicitly state that SCIA will handle the Request for Proposal (RFP) process, bid awarding, and construction oversight.

Financial Terms: Confirm the County of Salem is responsible for all construction costs. SCIA is charging a management fee a common 2.5% fee.

Project Management: Designate SCIA as the lead agency and project manager for the duration of the build.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Salem County Improvement Authority is authorized to enter into a shared service agreement with the County of Salem for the services described above.
